Goals

• Development of personal relationships with Jesus

First and foremost, the aim of the Unity Baptist Youth program is to lead and guide youth in knowing Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith. Every other goal is secondary.

• Strong peer relationships within the youth group

Relationship is at the core of our faith in Jesus, as we show love to others we demonstrate the love of Christ to our broken world.

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." (John 13:34-35)

• Developing hearts and attitudes of service both in the church and broader community

Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. (John 13:14-15)

• Positive mentoring relationships between sponsors and youth
